

Responsibilities

We all have responsibilities, as outlined below, to ensure that the remote learning works well and all children can continue learning.

School Responsibilities

- ◇ Provide daily learning activities for pupils
- ◇ Support the parents in the delivery of the learning
- ◇ Maintain responsibility for child welfare and safeguarding
- ◇ Provide individual learning as needed
- ◇ Ensure pupils have access to technology or provide alternative learning

Parent Responsibilities

- ◇ Ensure children are available to learn each day
- ◇ Report any absences to school
- ◇ Ensure children have equipment to access the learning—report any problems with this to school
- ◇ Ensure E-safety is in place

Pupil Responsibilities

- ◇ Be on time to start daily learning
- ◇ Complete all learning tasks to the best of your ability
- ◇ Behave online as you would in school—follow the school rules
- ◇ Tell an adult if you have any problems with the learning
- ◇ Keep yourself safe online

What is Remote Learning?

Remote learning is where a child is completing their school work at home as they are unable to attend school.

Why will Remote Learning be needed?

During the Coronavirus pandemic there may be reasons for a child to stay at home and complete their learning.

These reasons are:

- ◇ *The child has Covid symptoms & is waiting for test results*
- ◇ *A family member has tested positive for Covid & the family is isolating*
- ◇ *The school class bubble has a positive case and is isolating*
- ◇ *The whole school is isolating*

If your child is isolating at home for Covid related reasons please inform the school office as soon as possible.

If there is a class bubble or whole school closure we will inform you and set out the arrangements for you child during the isolation period.

Remote Learning at Leverton Academy

As a school we have planned how your child will continue to learn if they have to remain at home. Below outlines the two approaches:

An individual or small number of children are isolating:

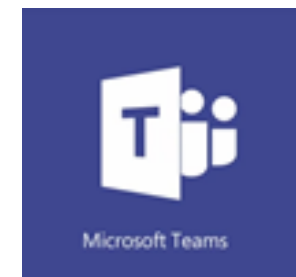
- ◇ You will be directed to video lessons from the Oak Academy which will be linked to the learning that the other children in school are completing
- ◇ Your child will be set activities to complete linked to these lessons
- ◇ Your child's class teacher will respond to the learning and any questions at the end of the day

Whole Class bubble or school isolating:

- ◇ Your child will login to a live register with their teacher at 9.00am
- ◇ They will be directed to video lessons that have been pre-recorded by their class teacher
- ◇ They will complete activities after these video lessons
- ◇ The class teacher will feedback to the learning
- ◇ At 2.30pm the class teacher will be live for whole class feedback
- ◇ At 3.00pm a class story will be available

Microsoft Teams

Our remote learning will be delivered via Microsoft Teams. Please make sure you have downloaded the app onto the device you are planning to use. Your child will be given their own individual login.



E-Safety

When your child is working on their device please ensure that the correct filters are in place and you are monitoring their internet use.

Free School Meals

If you are eligible for free school meals and your child has to isolate please contact the school office to arrange a school lunch.

In the event of a class bubble or school closure we will provide you with a food voucher.

Attendance

Your child will be expected to login to the live register on a daily basis at 9.00am.

If your child is unwell or unable to attend the register then please contact the school office if the school is open. In the event of a whole school closure please let us know of your child's absence via the office dojo or parents@levertonacademy.co.uk
